10. **Ann Ellen WOODS**, daughter of William WOODS and Elizabeth HAWORTH, was born on 21 August 1888 in Accrington.¹⁸ The address was: 4 Edlestone St. She was baptised on 12 September 1888 in St Paul's, Oswaldtwistle, Lancs.¹⁸ She died in 1889 in Accrington.¹
